We will strive to continuously revise our services, terms and conditions to ensure fairness to our customers.

- Please note that there will be no make-up sessions or refunds for training cancellations caused by wet weather.
- The fee for any cancelled training session will be retained as credit and can be used towards future payments, such as Games Participation Fees, Attire Fees, or upcoming Term Fees.
- In the event of unforeseen circumstances, including but not limited to the unavailability of ActiveSG/Bedok Green Primary School Netball Courts due to netball events, polling day, terrorist attacks, unhealthy PSI air conditions, or the spreading of contagious diseases such as SARS, HFMD, Zika, Covid-19, etc., training will be cancelled without the option for a make-up session or refund.
- Information regarding training cancellations due to wet weather or unforeseen circumstances will be communicated via Teamsnap for current players and on Whatsapp for Trial players.



Terms & Conditions

1. The Management

- 1.1. TKN reserves the right to modify its terms and conditions without prior notice
- 1.2. TKN retains the right to refuse or terminate a player's enrollment if they or their parents, fail to comply with our terms and conditions. Refunds will not be provided for any remaining training sessions or programmes.
- 1.3. TKN holds the right to dismiss any player who disrupts the class or coaches without issuing a refund.
- 1.4. While TKN strives to ensure your child's safety, we do not accept liability for any indirect or consequential injuries, damages, losses, or mishaps during our training session or other programmes.
- 1.5. TKN is not liable for any damaged, stolen, or lost valuables on the programme's premises.
- 1.6. TKN reserves the right to use photos and videos taken during our programmes for all its publicity or marketing purposes without seeking individual permission.

2. Administrative

- 2.1 Parents are required to keep TKN informed of any changes in their child's details, such as address, email and contact numbers. Please send written notifications to fun@thekidsnetwork.com.sg
- 2.2 It is the responsibility of parents to inform TKN about their child/ward's special medical conditions and allergies. However, our instructors will, under no circumstances, be obliged to ensure that the child's medical needs (such as administering or medication feeding) are met during the sessions.
- 2.3 Parents are responsible for monitoring their child's health. If a child is unwell, please seek immediate medical attention and refrain from sending them to our programmes.
- 2.4 If a child is found sick or has a fever during our programmes, TKN reserves the right to ask the child to refrain from participating without issuing a refund.

3. Fees and Payment

- 3.1 TKN reserves the right to change programmes fees and dates without prior notice.
- 3.2 Registration and payment for term fees begins one month before each term begins. Confirmation of a slot for the upcoming term is only guaranteed upon full payment.
- 3.3 Parents must inform us of any training dates their child will miss due to school activities, family travel plans, fasting during Ramadhan etc before making payment for a new term. Term fees will be prorated at a flat rate of \$\$48.00 per session (outdoor) / \$\$53.00 per session (indoor).
- 3.4 A one-time \$\$55 administration fee is charged to all new players, covering administrative costs, netball attire and a netball journal.
- 3.5 A S\$25 re-administration fee applies to players rejoining after a hiatus of 12 months or more.
- 3.6 A 10% early bird discount off term fees is applicable to all existing players who sign up for upcoming terms during the early bird period.
- 3.7 A 10% sibling discount off term fees is applicable to all sibling players signing up for upcoming terms. The discount is applicable every term for the term fees of the siblings.
- 3.8 A one-time 10% referral discount off term fees is applicable to players who refer a friend to join our training programmes. Only one referral discount is allowed per term, any more shall be redeemed in the next term.
- 3.9 Additional fees may be required for external games participations such as entry and umpiring fees for matches, carnivals, leagues, holiday programmes or overseas trips, and must be paid in full beforehand.
- 3.10 For major competitions, players may be required to purchase a competition netball uniform, distinct from the regular training uniform.
- 3.11 All fees paid are non-refundable and non-transferable, with no refunds for partial attendance. For any approved refunds, customers who have made payment via credit card or debit card on the website must bear the transaction fees.
- 3.12 If a child cannot attend games or carnival outside their usual venue or time, payment for those sessions is unnecessary.
- 3.13 Players temporarily halting training due to injury or medical reasons requiring over 4 weeks of recovery must submit relevant documents such as specialist notes within two weeks of incident.

Remaining session fees will be retained as credit and can be used towards future payments valid for 6 months. Administrative fee of \$80 is applicable for request of refund of remaining sessions fee.

- 3.14 Players withdrawing due to relocation must inform TKN within two weeks of withdrawal. Administrative fee of \$80 is applicable for request of refund of remaining sessions fee.
- 3.15 Session fee refund or rollover as credit will not be applicable for last minute absence or medical certificates

Code of Conduct

- Be respectful to your coaches, staff, team-mates, opponents, officials and spectators
- Provide support and encouragement to team-mates and opponents alike
- Play fairly by adhering to the rules and regulation of the game
- Demonstrate sportsmanship during games, showing humility in victory and grace in defeat
- Respect the decision of the officials; any disputes should be addressed through your coach
- Inform your coaches promptly if you are feeling unwell or have sustained an injury
- Take responsibility for the care and proper use of equipment and facilities provided to you

Spectator's Code of Conduct

- Never ridicule or yell at a child for mistakes or losses. Support all efforts to remove verbal and physical abuse
- Lead by example. Applaud good play from all players and provide encouragement through their mistakes
- Should you disagree with the coach or officials, address the issue through appropriate channels rather than publicly questioning their judgement
- Recognise and respect the value and importance of coaches, staff, officials and volunteers.
